OUR PROGRAMS

Phonological Analysis with Synthetic Phonics *PASP - A Comprehensive Reading Program:*

Research over the past 30 years has clearly identified a weakness in phonological processing (also called phonemic awareness) as a primary cause of reading problems. This skill is the ability to judge the number, order and identity of individual sounds in the language. This research forms the basis of the PASP program. This is a comprehensive reading program, not just an introduction to reading, and routinely results in multiple year gains in reading for the students.

Dyslexia is characterized by difficulties with accurate and/or fluent word recognition, poor spelling, and weak decoding skills. It is essentially a difficulty with reading that is not accounted for by low intelligence or lack of instruction. It is not due to the letters of the words being visually misplaced or reversed by the individual, a common misconception.

ReadingFish A Reading and Listening Comprehension Program:

Struggles in reading comprehension typically arise from a lack of concept imagery. This is a difficulty creating accurate visual imagery from what is read, resulting in comprehension problems and limited vocabulary development.

ReadingFish is an intensive reading and listening program. This program integrates and sequentially applies three types of instructional practices identified by independent research as effective for improving reading comprehension.

Orthography A Spelling Program with Symbol Imagery:

For students with adequate phonological processing skills but poor reading and spelling skills, we may recommend our Orthography Program. Orthographic instruction involves teaching the student about the rules that govern how words are spelled and pronounced. The result is an improved ability to accurately sound out and spell unfamiliar words.

Framing Your Thoughts A Multisensory Writing Program:

Our writing program provides students with a new and stress free method to complete any written language task or assignment.
